3. Management
A management strategy incorporating medical conditions, diet, exercise, socialization and training is developed to assist in changing your dog's behavior.
4. Modification Plan
Finally, a custom-tailored program is designed to help increase your dog's desire to engage in appropriate behaviors. There are no quick fixes. Behavior rarely changes overnight. A loving and systematic approach that addresses the cause of unwanted behaviors, and not just the symptoms, is the key to a fulfilling long-term relationship with your pet.
